Ascertain the correct fuel requirements for the vehicle e.g.; (Diesel, LPG (liquid petroleum gas) or U.L.P. (Unleaded Petrol).</li> <li>2. Stop the vehicle with fuel tank inlet on same side as the fuel pump, and switch engine <u>OFF</u>.</li> <li>3. Turn off Mobile Telephone and Two-Way Radio.</li> <li>4. Remove fuel cap on vehicle and place it in a prominent place.</li> <li>5. Grasp fuel nozzle, lift from fuel pump and place in fuel tank (LPG screws onto tank neck).</li> <li>6. Set automatic cut-out which is incorporated in the fuel pump trigger assembly (if applicable).</li> <li>7. Allow fuel tank to fill.</li> <li>8. When automatic cut-out activates, grasp fuel nozzle and replace on fuel pump (unscrew for LPG filling).</li> <li>9. Replace fuel tank cap.</li> <li>10. Fill in vehicle log sheet as required.</li> <li>11. Check around the vehicle prior to starting and driving off.</li> <li>12. Turn Mobile Telephone and Two - Way Radio back on.</li> </ol> <p><u>NO SMOKING/NAKED FLAMES.</u> <u>DO NOT INHALE VAPOUR</u></p>	1 2 3 4
