Purpose

This instruction is to ensure safe use of the Shower Water Heater Located at the two amenities blocks on The Bunkers Conservation Reserve in accordance with Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA) All members and visitors while working at The Bunkers Conservation Reserve must comply with the Act as per the definition of a Worker.

The water heaters are wood fired and Fire Restrictions and Fire Ban Days must be taken into account before lighting either of the water heaters also water must be used sparingly.

Hot water for the showers is heated via the wood fired heaters and following must be observed for the safe use of the heaters.

1. Water Heater Operating Instructions

- Ensure water is turned on at the main tank and sufficient water is in the tank to maintain water pressure for shower.
- Ensure Stop cock at water heater is turned on and water flows when hot water tap is turned on.
- Light small wood fire at base of the heater in the firebox and maintain fire for approx 15 to 20 minutes to heat water fully.

2. Shower Use

- Once the water is hot enough use hot and cold taps to set temperature as per normal shower
- On completion of shower turn off taps for shower head
- Leave fire in heater to burn down and go out
- Check to ensure fire has gone out and is safe before leaving area.
