Purpose

This instruction is to ensure safe use of the work trailer located at The Bunkers Conservation Reserve in accordance with Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA)

All members and visitors while working at The Bunkers Conservation Reserve must comply with the Act as per the definition of a Worker.

Note: Trailer is not registered and cannot be towed outside of The Bunkers Conservation Reserve.

1. Prestart

Before using the trailer check the following:

- Trailer is in good condition
- Wheels are on tight
- Tailgate is closed and secure
- Tyre pressures of road tyres and spares (36 PSI min)
- Ensure Coupling is in serviceable condition

2. Hooking Trailer onto Tow Vehicle

- Ensure Coupling is in good condition
- Ensure Chains are in good condition
- Ensure 50mm tow ball is properly secured to vehicle and in good condition
- Once trailer is hooked on ensure coupling has fully engaged and locked
- Attach safety chain to vehicle.

3. Loading of Trailer

- Trailer is a 750kilogram trailer and must not be loaded beyond this weight
- Load must be properly secured when towing
- People must not ride in trailer at any time.
